Collegeville Borough Police Department

The Collegeville Police Department is located in the Borough Municipal Building and serves the residents of the Borough and Ursinus College Campus. Residents of the Borough can reach the police by calling **610.489.9332**. This phone is manned by dispatchers at the Montgomery County Emergency Dispatch Service in Eagleville. Of course, call **911** for emergencies.

TRASH & RECYCLING PICK-UP

Collegeville Borough's trash and recycling pick-up is provided by **Quality Disposal**. Our trash and recyclables are picked up once each week on Tuesdays. The limit for trash is currently three (3) bags or containers. Residents are also required to recycle. Recycling should be co-mingled and placed in the recycling bin provided by the Borough.

Recycling shall include the following:

- Aluminum beverage cans, steel and tin food cans (remove lids); clear, green and brown glass jars and bottles;
- plastic bottles marked No. 1 or 2 on the bottom, discard lids and flatten plastic;
- newspapers, magazines and phone books tied with string or placed in paper bag.
- Corrugated cardboard must be cut down, tied and bundled.
- Home office/junk mail should be placed in a brown paper bag or with newspapers.

Damaged or missing recycle bins can be replaced by stopping by the Borough Municipal Building. The cost of a replacement bin is \$10.00. Bulk item pick-up can be scheduled by calling Quality Disposal at **610.286.5172**.

Compost Site

Collegeville Borough, along with Trappe Borough, operate a compost site on West Seventh Avenue in Trappe. Only residents of the two Boroughs may drop off yard waste at the compost site. Residents may drop off yard waste free of charge. **Identification will be required.** Residents and non-residents are permitted to take compost and mulch free of charge. Days of operation are Wednesday and Saturdays. Call the Public Works Department at 610.489.2831 for hours.
