Important Clarification for Residents Concerning the Pick Up of Debris September 16, 2021

Please note: The debris contractor <u>will not</u> pick up any food waste or waste in black plastic bags. Clear plastic bags are okay.

All debris must be placed within 10 feet of the curb. Debris eligible for collection under the MontCo program must be able to be clearly identified by collectors *(i.e., no black trash bags)*. Multiple collections for each debris type will occur over the next 30 days. Please try to avoid placing debris near poles, mailboxes, and under electric lines as much as possible.

Debris collection will continue until the County and Collegeville Borough have determined there is no longer a need. *Any questions please call the Collegeville Borough Office at 610-489-9208*

Debris included in the County contract—Please separate as follows:

• *White goods* – This includes appliances such as refrigerators, washers, dryers, etc. White good pickup is scheduled on specific days in conjunction with the debris management contractor.

- Vegetative Debris Trees, branches, leaves, plants
- Construction Debris Drywall, carpet, furniture, and building material.
- *Electronics* TVs radios, DVD players, computers

Debris that is <u>not</u> included in the MontCo contract:

• Household garbage – bagged garbage, discarded food, paper, packaging. These items will not be collected under the County debris management program and should be collected by the residents' municipal trash provider

• *Household Hazardous Waste* – Oil, pesticides, cleaners, paint. MCDPS is exploring the option of expanding the debris management contract to include household hazardous waste. Residents can also sign up to dispose these items at the next Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day, which is scheduled for Saturday, Sept. 25 at Spring-Ford 9th Grade Center, 400 South Lewis Rd., Royersford. https://www.montcopa.org/706/Household-Hazardous-Waste-Collection-Pro
