Some items are not able to be recycled and require specific disposal methods.

- **Plastic Bags (grocery bags)**
- **Paper plates / paper towels (any paper / plastic products containing food waste)**
- **Large metal items**
- **Plastic wrap (food coverings)**
- **Wrapping paper**
- **Windows / mirrors (home / auto)**
- **Chemicals (cleaners / pesticides / paints / stains)**

Special Disposal Required

Some items are electronic waste, hazardous waste, or required to be disposed of by alternate means, and can not be taken in the single stream recycle collection.

- Tires
 - Batteries
 - Televisions
 - Computers
 - Paints / stains
 - Used clothing
 - Automotive oils / parts
 - Chemicals (cleaners / pesticides / paints / stains)

Loose items placed in the recycle bin are less likely to pose an issue at the recycling facility. If bags are used, they must be clear!

Please do not bag your recycle items when placed in the bin!

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

Single stream recycling otherwise known as "Sole Source" recycling makes your job much easier!

Single stream recycling is the term used to describe the procedure that does not require the separation of qualifying materials before collection.

This practice of recycling has many benefits as a result, such as an increased participation level, as there is less "leg work" to be done by the home owner. Another immediate benefit is the need for only one recycle collection vehicle reducing the carbon footprint of the collection route.

Where does it all go?

We haul your trash to *Covanta of Plymouth incinerator*. (115 Conshohocken Rd, Conshohocken PA)

We haul your recyclable materials to *Cougle's Recycling*. (1000 S. Fourth St, Hamburg, PA)

Trash & Recycle placement / Theft prevention.

- ✓ Carts should be with at least 3 feet clearance from mailboxes, poles, lampposts, vehicles and each other.
- ✓ Please do not put anything you do not wish to be picked up near your carts. For example, lawn chairs, portable basketball hoops, bicycles, etc.
- ✓ Place trash and recycle out curbside by midnight, prior to your trash collection.



Service Schedule

Trash and Recycle are to be collected one time per week on Tuesday.

The only holiday affecting Tuesday's service day for 2023 will 4th of July, service will take place on Wednesday.

In the future, only if the service day lands on any of the following holidays, the service will be continued the following day.

Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.

Bulk Item Collection

Please contact your municipal office, or a private junk hauler for large bulk item collection.

Bulk Items: "large items of solid waste including, but not limited to, *appliances, large auto parts, furniture and large trees and branches*, which require collection in other than conventional compactor refuse collection vehicles. The waste will also include items that require special handling and shall include but not be limited to *Freon containing appliances*, appliances containing HCFC's, CFC's, etc.
