

NOTICE OF ROAD WORK

COLLEGEVILLE BOROUGH RESIDENTS

Derr, Freeland, Hunsicker, Ruby, Shelly, Stine, and Spangler

Your development is scheduled to receive a preventative maintenance treatment called Ultra-Thin Bonded Wearing Course. This process is a high-performance thin paving system designed to both seal your street as well as providing a new road surface.

To prepare your streets to receive this paving process the necessary prep work will be completed. The first step will be to spot treat the random distressed areas with a Chip Seal. Do not be alarmed as this treatment is only going to be completed to approximately 10% of the roadway area and any remaining loose aggregate from this treatment will be swept and removed within a few days of this application. The second step will be to seal the remaining cracks with a rubberized crack sealant. The final preparation step which will be completed a few days in advance of the paving treatment will be to mill the necessary notches to allow for a smooth transition at limits of work.

The streets will remain open during all phases of construction, but please travel slowly for the safety of yourself and our workers. Also please pay attention to the No Parking Signs which will be installed in advance of our operations. You will receive another orange notification a few days in advance of the final paving treatment.

Please see the back of this notification for an approximate schedule of operations. Keep in mind that our schedule is subject to change due to potential weather and construction delays.
